**TEACHING**

**BEHAVIOR**

If needed, am I following the Behavior Intervention Plan and does all appropriate staff members understand the plan?

Am I taking data as appropriate and are my data up to date?

How well am I able to manage, support, and form positive relationships with both the staff that serve my classroom and the parents of my students?
