6 Ways to Use Inclusive Practices as a Framework for Redesigning Education

1	Re-story	Re-Story students by designing experiences that recognize their inherent potential and build upon their strengths.
2	Redesign	Redesign instruction and assessment through meaningful, differentiated tasks that provide students with multiple ways to demonstrate knowledge and understanding
3	Restructure	Restructure intervention and enrichment so that the receipt of services is not contingent upon artificial labels.
4	Revitalize	Revitalize co-teaching to maximize the talents of staff and provide them with collaborative structures that support their work.
5	Realign	Realign service delivery to more flexibly meet the needs of all learners.
6	Reconceptualize	Reconceptualize equity so that disability is included as just another form of diversity, and to ensure that student outcomes are not predictive based upon demographic variables.
