Healing Actions

- 1. The Environment
 - attend to overall environmental stimulation
 - safe places/routines
 - "no changes on Monday"
- 2. Adult & Student Relationship
 - be an anchor
 - entrust
 - re-think traditional classroom management strategies
 - o avoid techniques that shame
 - o step away from contingencies
 - o broaden your concept of accountability
 - o private redirects (go-to-questions)
- 3. Student Perception of Self
 - envision
 - invite reflection with your caring guidance
 - intentionally build toward self-regulation
