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Checklists for Implementing a *PSP Approach* to Teaming

The Early Intervention Teaming Handbook, Second Edition, includes a set of four checklists using the characteristics and implementation conditions of the primary service provider (PSP) approach in order to assist teams with implementing a PSP approach to teaming. Below is more information about each checklist included in the book.

1 Preparing for a Team-Based Approach

This checklist includes practice indicators for establishing cohesive, geographically-based teams.

2 Using a Primary Service Provider

This checklist includes indicators for selecting a PSP for a specific child and family as well as documenting the presence of coaching by the PSP with family members, care providers, and other team members.

3 Coordinating Joint Visits

This checklist includes indicators for implementing joint visits between the PSP and other team members with the family or other care provider.

4 Conducting Team Meetings

This checklist includes indicators for conducting effective team meetings virtually or in-person.
