Virtual workshop format

Five 2-hour webinars over a 5-week period (see full schedule below) are interactive and **require pre-webinar learning activities and participation from each attendee**. Learning activities include readings and responses, self-reflection about practices and perspectives, video observations, writing positive feedback statements or reflections, practicing with a measure, or other activities. Each 5-webinar series is equivalent to a 2-day workshop.
